#### APRIL 2018:

##### School Inaugural Function:

### GANESH UTSAV:

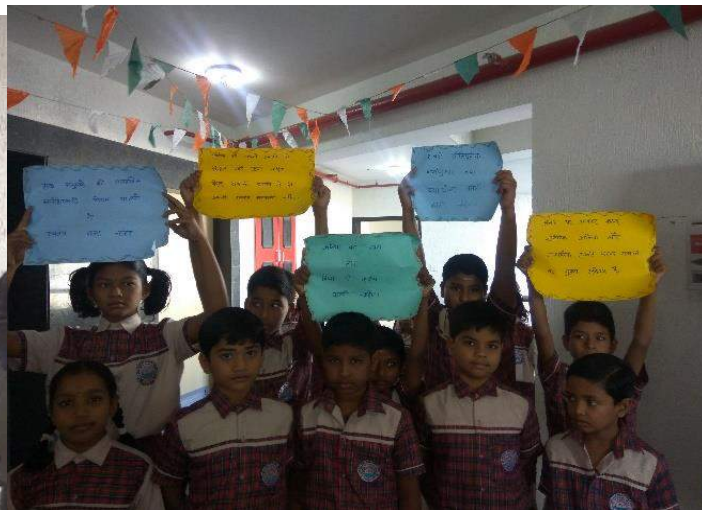
